The Contract is allocated regionally to respond to public safety incidents on a 24 hour / 365 day basis.

The initial emergency response is to attend a public safety incident within 4 hours of notification to erect temporary fencing and warning notices, and ensure the hazard is secured.

Hazards related to past coal mining present issues such as ground collapses of shafts and adits, and minewater and gas outbreaks, therefore, the following types of remedial works may be required:-

Filling of open shafts/adits/mine-workings/voids.

Mass concrete plugging of shafts/adits/mine-workings/voids.

Reinforced concrete capping of shafts/adits.

Treatment of fissures.

Permanent fencing of hazards.

Associated works including reinstatement, maintenance works to Coal Authority sites and tips. Similar works may be required for non coal related matters.

Individual work packages range from approx £500 to £100k, depending upon the nature and location of the incident.

The Contract will commence 1 April 2011 and be for a 4 year period.

A minimum 5 / maximum of 6 of the highest scoring organisations per region will be invited to Tender.

The Authority are looking to appoint one Contractor per region dependent upon the Contractor's capacity, resources and technical capabilities to undertake the contract requirement.

This Contract will be available for use by other UK Public Bodies including Central Government Departments, their Agencies, NDPB's, NHS bodies and Public Authorities for similar types of services.
