II.4) SHORT DESCRIPTION OF NATURE AND SCOPE OF WORKS

The Contract is allocated regionally to respond to public safety incidents on a 24 hour / 365 day basis.

The initial response is to attend a public safety incident within 4 hours of notification to erect temporary fencing and warning notices, and ensure the hazard is secured.

The following types of remedial works may be required:-

Filling of open shafts/adits/mine-workings/voids.

Mass concrete plugging of shafts/adits/mine-working/voids.

Reinforced concrete capping of shafts/adits.

Treatment of fissures.

Permanent fencing.

Associated works including reinstatement, maintenance works to Coal Authority sites and tips.

Individual work packages range from approximately £500 to £20k, depending upon the nature and location of the incident.

This Contract will be available for use by other UK Public Bodies including Central Government Departments, their agencies, NDPB's, NHS bodies and Public Authorities for similar types of services.
